- We will count using topic based objects.
- We will be adding one more to a quantity.
- We will look for numbers and shapes around us.
- We will continue to look at numbers every day by introducing a number of the week to the children.
- We will also introduce Ten Town to the children and use rhymes to assist our number formation.
- We will work together to represent this number in different ways i.e. claps, objects and the number.
- We will look at the shapes that we spot within different nursery rhymes
- We will sing songs such as 5 little speckled frogs to assist our counting, adding and taking away!

Understanding of the World

We will look at where the different nursery rhyme characters might live and how the differ from each other $\,$

We will carry out a 'Who done it' when Humpty Dumpty falls from the wall! We will use clues to help us to solve the mystery!

- We will have a visit from a local musician who will sing traditional songs with us!

Communication and Language

- We will listen to a range of nursery rhymes and join in when we can!
- We will recreate through drama story lines from nursery rhymes
- We will join in with familiar nursery rhymes
- We will use positional language to find items that our teachers will hide.
- We will extend our vocabulary when sharing stories.
- We will have a nursery rhyme role play that will coincide with the rhyme of the week!
- We will sing many different nursery rhymes!
- We will play lots of rhyming circle games
- More games such as memory games, turn taking games and talking games will be played to encourage children to listen and talk in groups.
- We will draw different characters from nursery rhymes.
- We will continue to develop our blending skills.
- We will begin to look at our names in cursive writing.
- · We will continue to develop our pencil grips
- We will continue to use 'Squiggle Whilst We Wiggle' to enhance our gross motor skills ahead of writing!
- We will follow prewriting patterns!
- We will identify words that rhyme
- We will read many rhyming stories and make silly soup using rhyming words!
