

### Communication & Language (C&L)

- We will listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- We will learn to respond appropriately to a range of questions.
- We will learn to respond to instructions.
- We will use talk in pretending.
- We will learn new words and use talk to connect our ideas.

### Literacy (L)

- We will share a range of fiction and non-fiction books about the people who help us, winter and Christmas.
- We will begin to recall key events from stories.
- We will experiment with marks using a range of tools.
- We will begin to give meanings to our marks.
- We will begin to listen for initial sounds in words.
- We will write our names in Christmas cards.

### Mathematics (M)

- We will pretend to be shop keepers and explore using money.
- We will look for shapes in the environment.
- We will match numbers on emergency vehicles.
- We will count objects.
- We will begin to represent numbers.
- We will use shapes to build.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

- We will begin to express our own preferences and interests.
- We will share our play with others.
- We will talk about our feelings.
- We will learn to help others.
