

Communication & Language (C&L)

- We will join in with repeating refrains and anticipate key events in stories.
- We will begin to understand 'how' and 'why' questions.
- We will use talk in pretending.
- We will increase our vocabulary to reflect the breadth of our experiences.

Literacy (L)

- We will share a range of fairytales and traditional tales.
- We will explore mark making and learn to label pictures with marks or initial sounds.
- We will begin to blend and segment sounds in words.
- We will write our own wishes and spells.

Mathematics (M)

- We will measure our own beanstalks.
- We will sort and count beans.
- We will use shapes to create our own castles.
- We will order numbers to 5 and find missing numbers.
- We will learn to say the number that is one more than a given number.
- We will compare groups of objects and use the language 'more' and 'a lot'.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

- We will join in and begin to play in a group.
- We will have responsibility for small tasks.
- We will begin to accept the needs of others and to share resources.
