### Place value:

- We will explore 1 More and 1 Less than different numbers
- We will create different Number sequences
- We will investigate grouping and sorting of numbers and objects

### Addition and Subtraction

- We will compare numbers and quantities
- We will count, write and read any number to 10
- We will investigate missing numbers

### Cross curricular maths

We will use our maths skills to help us count and sort all the natural objects that we find outside!

## English
