

Nearly 12 months ago we informed you that we were going to explore the possibility of creating a multi academy trust alongside Kingsfield First and Oxhey First Schools in Biddulph and Reginald Mitchell Primary School In Kidsgrove. We have now received permission to commence this process. If successful we aim to convert to an academy on 1st April 2019. There will be information regarding this change shared with you as we have it. In short this will not change our school. Instead it will add strength via collaboration and redirect funding directly back to our school rather than to the local authority and therefore benefit your children.
