Use finger spaces and a full stop. 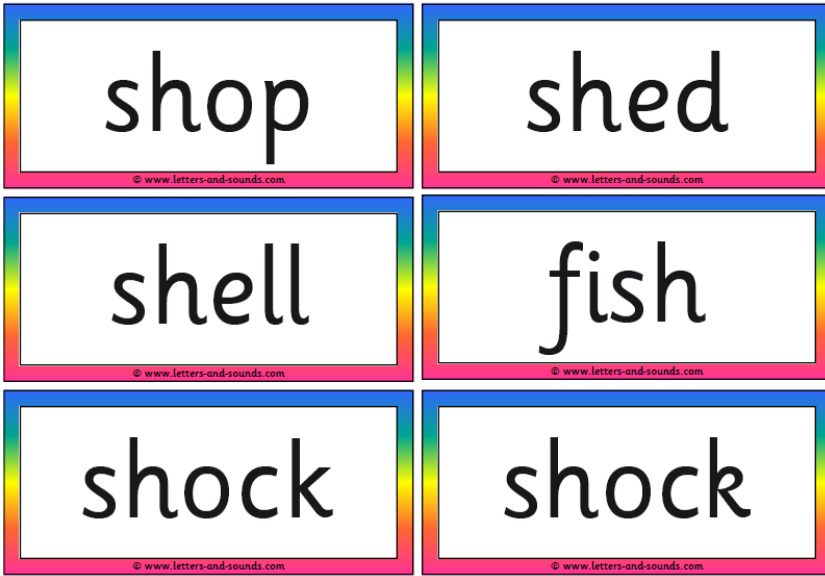

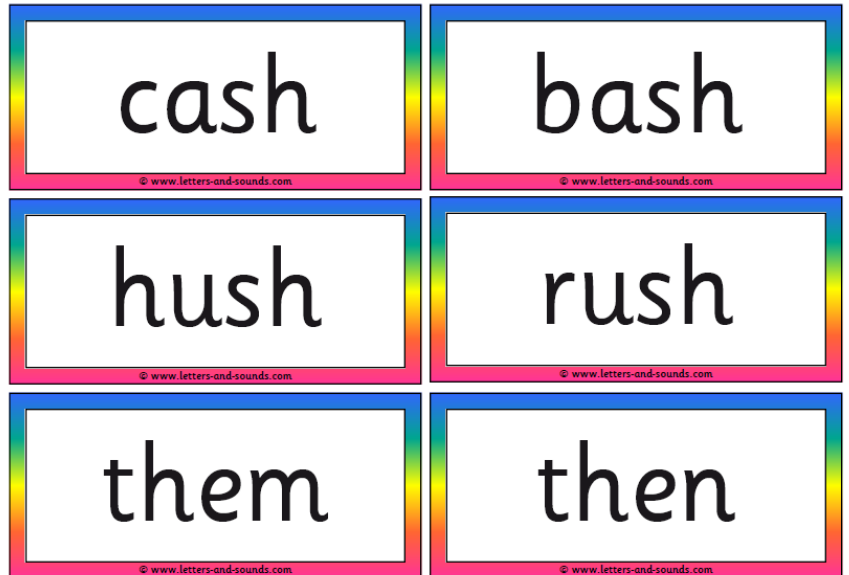

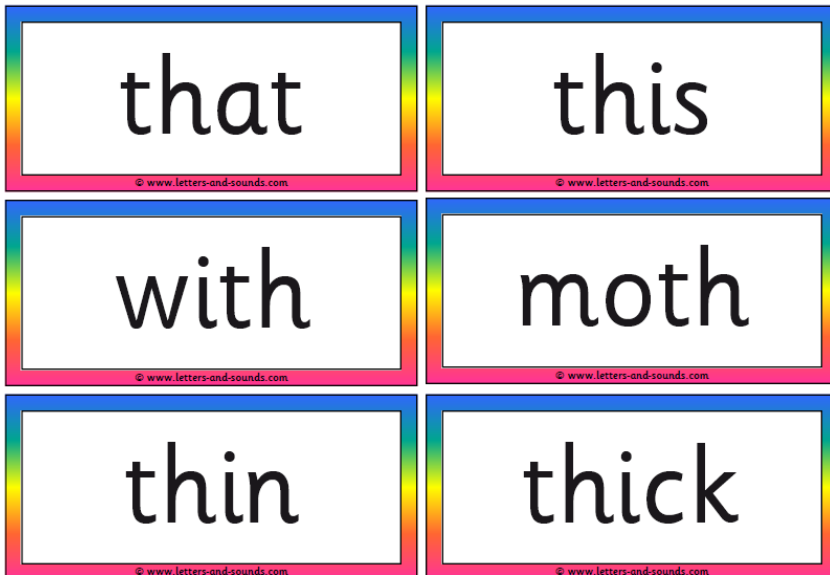
