Set Menu: Timetables, spellings, daily reading, phonics practice

Once children are able to read fluently, and with expression, hold discussions around their comprehension of the texts, (we will provide a bank of ideas to support this). If your child is reluctant to read, they could listen to audio books. We want them to foster a love of books, so please don't underestimate the value of reading to your child.

Added Extras:

We will encourage your child to complete as many of the activities from the menu as they like at home, but NO LESS than 3 over the half term, This can be recorded (if appropriate) in our homework books. We will ask for homework books in during the last week of each half term in order for us to share and celebrate this learning.

Read it	Research it	Design it
Listen to a range of transport stories. You could visit the local library if you do not have any at home.	Experience a method of transport. You could have a ride on a coach, bus or a train. You could even ride on a steam train at Churnet Valley Railway. You could also visit a local museum such as Hanley museum to see a spitfire.	Design a vehicle with some interesting features. For example, a superhero aeroplane with a cape, a flying train etc.
Practise it	Write it	Make it
Practise listening for words that rhyme. You could use books to see if you can pick out any rhyming pairs. You could draw or stick pictures of rhyming pairs in your book.	Practise writing your name with cursive letters. Remember to use a capital letter at the beginning. Can you learn the handwriting rhymes for the letters in your name?
