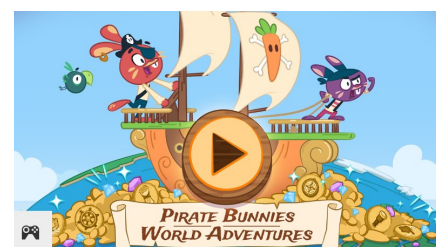

How to Find Captain Knypersley's Treasure



1. Drop your anchor at the bottom of the island when you see the spooky shack.

9. Finally, Dig for treasure!





