

The T-Rex lived in North American forests.


Dinosaurs suddenly became extinct.

The T-Rex was one of the largest and most powerful 9 meat-eating dinosaurs that has ever lived on our 16 planet. Standing up to a huge six metres tall and 26 at up to twelve metres long, the T-Rex moved 36 quickly with its strong and powerful thighs. 44 Their powerful jaws meant that they could eat 51 their prey in one bite. The T-Rex had guite a large 61 71 brain and this helped it to hunt better. The T-Rex lived in the forests and river valleys of North 80 America before becoming extinct around sixty-87 five millions years ago but nobody can agree for 95 sure why all dinosaurs suddenly became extinct 103 108 at this time.

Can you work out the values of each shape?


