Select Key Stage 1, then English and then Phonics. Click on Ash's phonics. Can you say the sound for each of the graphemes on Ash's skateboarding track? If your child was unsure of some of Polly's sounds from yesterday, continue with Polly's phonics instead of completing Ash's phonics. If there are any that you do not know, click on the sound to watch the video and play the game. If there are lots that your child is unsure of, just choose a few.</p>	<p>Can you practise reading the common exception words in your red Home School Links book?</p> <p>How many can you read?</p>
<p>History</p> 	<p>Bronze</p> <p>Ask your grown up to share the information about pirates with you. Draw one of the famous pirates. What is their name? Why are they famous?</p>	<p>Silver</p> <p>Read about the famous pirates with your grown up. Draw him/her and write facts about them. Who did you choose and why? Can you tell your family about the pirate?</p>	<p>Gold</p> <p>Create a fact page about a famous pirate. You could research him/her further on Kidrex. Think about how you could present your work. Share your new facts with your family!</p>
