	<p>Collect some 2p coins. How many of each coin have you got?</p> <p>Can you count different amounts of money using all 2p coins? For example, choose five 2p coins, count in 2s to find that the total is 10p.</p>	<p>Collect some 2p, 5p and 10p coins. How many of each coin have you got?</p> <p>Can you count different amounts of money using all 2p, 5p or 10p coins (one type of coin at a time, not mixed)? For example, choose five 2p coins, count in 2s to find that the total is 10p.</p>	<p>Can you make an amount of money using mixed coins (up to £1)? Have you used the least possible amount of coins? If not can you swap some of the coins to make the amount using less coins?</p> <p>For example, 25p can be made in lots of different ways including:</p> <p><math>10p+10p+5p=25p</math>  <math>5p+5p+5p+5p+5p=25p</math></p> <p>But if we were to use the smallest amount of coins we would use</p> <p><math>20p+5p=25p</math></p> <p>Explore different amounts, making them in different ways and finding the way that uses the least amount of coins. Can you record your investigation?</p>
