Handwriting

- Let's get squiggling
 - Dough Disco
- Read Write Inc Rhymes
- Funky Fingers/ Fine motor
 - Pencil Control

Reading

- CAL*** - Huge importance. Listening and comprehending what has happened in the story
- Asking a lot of questions while reading a story
- Reading activities will be accessed daily
 - ERIC sessions daily
- Supporting reading at home - bedtime stories, model reading, signs on the street and shops.
 - Handling reading books

Phonics

- Phase 1 phonics - where do we start? Listening skills - instrumental sounds, environmental sounds, oral sounds.
 - Rhyming stories/ Nursery rhymes.
 - Daily phonics sessions
 - Literacy to have a phonics focus
 - Blending and segmenting
 - Phoneme and Grapheme
 - Jolly Phonics - toolkit
 - 'er'ing' s'err
- Pronunciation - be aware of American YouTube Videos - Mr Thorne, Jolly Phonics.

Writing

- Name writing
- Drawing
- CAL - focus on language prior to writing
 - Pencil grip
 - Model writing to your children
- Promoting writing at home - shopping list
