Over the next week your child will bring home their design for you then to be able to place your order online. The same way as last year.

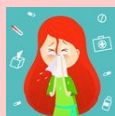
Once your order form has been received you will need to return the completed by Monday 12th October

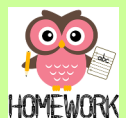
