#### **COVID** winter support



Staffordshire County Council are offering emergency help to Staffordshire residents.

If you are struggling to pay your fuel bills, you could get up to £200 worth of financial help. This will be provided by pre-paid meter credit or paid directly to your energy provider to add credit to your account or to clear prior debt.

You could be eligible to benefit from the scheme if you meet one of the below criteria:

Claim benefits or tax credits (including Universal Credit)

- Have low or no income
- Are disabled
- Are currently unemployed

#### Time to say goodbye ...


