In English lessons your child will have the opportunity to listen to, read and write in different styles (genres) such as instructions, stories and reports, to name but a few. They will use speaking and listening, and drama to support and inspire their writing.

Throughout the Maths lessons your child will develop a variety of strategies in mental and written maths using the CPA model-concrete (using objects such as Numicon, counters etc) pictorial (drawing) and abstract (doing it in their head). We use White Rose Maths and other resources


