Our Curriculum



Our curriculum is creatively linked and organised flexibly to provide exciting, practical and written learning opportunities which our children thrive on. Skills are progressive and are developed in all subjects. For more information please visit the website and click on Our School, Curriculum and scroll down.



In English lessons your child will have the opportunity to listen to, read and write in different styles (genres) such as instructions, stories and reports, to name but a few. They will use speaking and listening, and drama to support and inspire their writing.

Throughout the Maths lessons your child will develop a variety of strategies in mental and written maths using the CPA model—concrete (using objects such as Numicon, counters etc.) pictorial (drawing) and abstract (doing it in their head). We use White Rose Maths and other resources to compliment and expand their knowledge.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED

Where in the world is Knypersley?



As we welcome the children back to a new school year we begin with a fabulous topic—Where in the world is Knypersley. We will explore our local area and focus on key geography skills where possible. The English is often linked to our topic and the maths follows the White Rose maths units.

Our Amazing African Adventure.



After the Christmas break we move on to - Our Amazing African Adventure. This topic is great for learning about the wider world and the children always enjoy the amazing art work and animal activities. Our English links to texts where possible and we continue to work through the White Rose maths units.

Bright Lights, Big City!



In to the summer and we start our final unit - Bright light, Big city! This topic focusses on the sight and sounds of our capital City—London. We enjoy fantastic virtual tours and learn all about the sights and attractions. Some of our texts link with this and the children always love learning about The Great Fire and re-creating art work inspired by this. We continue to work through the White Rose maths units.
