
Mary and Joseph had to travel to Bethlehem to register in a census. A kind innkeeper in Bethlehem let Mary and Joseph stay in his stable for the night.




At the same time, an angel appeared to some shepherds. The angel told them that the son of God had been born in Bethlehem.
