

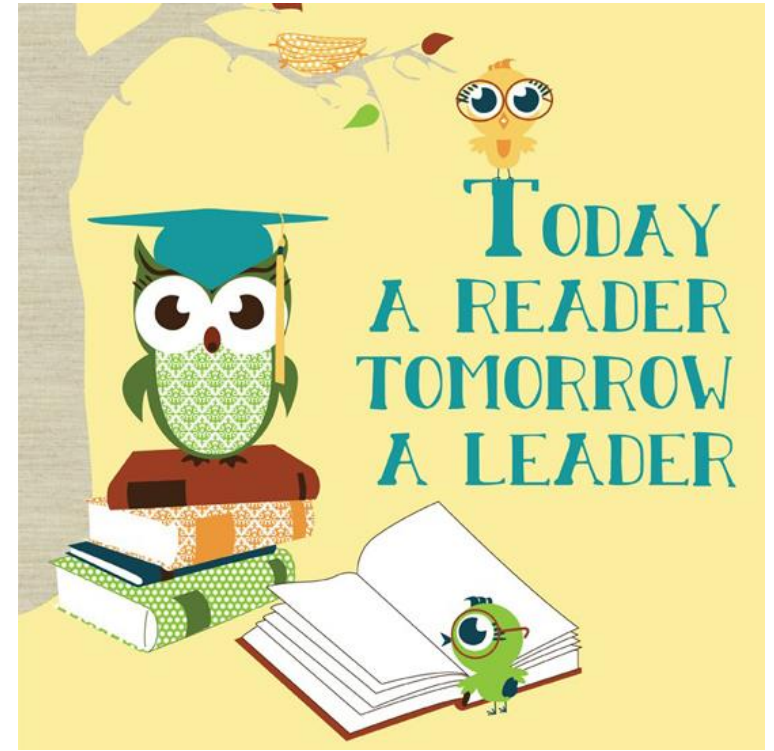

# Reading

Please use the following PowerPoints:

- CVC word reading
- Speed reading Phase 3



Please use the PowerPoints as reading aids for your child. It is really important that they continue their hard work with reading. Your child is currently working through Phase 3, please keep them familiar with the diagraphs by reading using them.

## Reading games:

Sticker charts have been updated please use these to support reading games.

- Word Chase - write words on paper and stick around the house children go to find them as quick as they can!
- BINGO- Make a BINGO grid on paper, pull out sounds or words children mark off as you say.
- I-Spy- Place words or sounds from sticker charts around the house can children read and spy them.
- Reading time- Reading with and too your child is very important. Can they spot words that they know in books can they handle the books read and discuss what happens within them.
- School reading books - read once for decoding skills, again for speed and fluency and again for comprehension - Who, What, Where and How questions.
- Jolly Phonics videos on Youtube - Phase 2 and Phase 3
- Alphablocks episodes - Cbeebies.

# Writing

The following PowerPoint can be used to support writing:

- Caption Examples
- Captions and pictures
- CVC words

Ideas for writing:

- Can your child write a sentence about their day: 'We went in the garden.'
- Read a story to your child, can they write a sentence about the story or a character.
- A shopping list.
- A recipe for a cake or a meal as your making it.
- 'I spy' list
- A Letter to their friends.

Cursive handwriting practise - sound mats - front of sticker chart.

## Activities to keep your child busy 😊

- Can your child use 'junk' to build a model.
- Draw a picture and talk about the picture that they have drawn.
- Use different types of construction and ask your child to draw what they have built and label it.
- You can write letters on types of construction and ask your child to use the blocks to make a word
- Make cakes ask the children to measure
- Alphablocks and Numberblocks episodes - Cbeebies.
- Board games - Snakes and Ladders, Jenga, Snap Ect.
