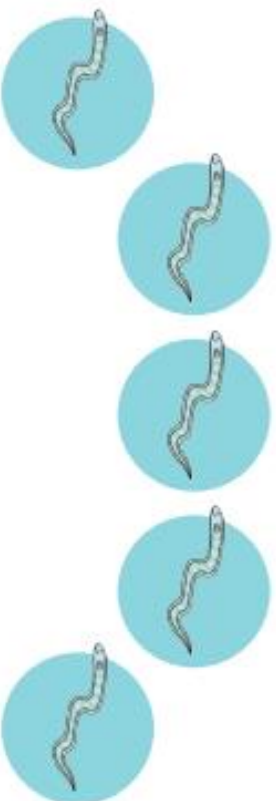
- 3 There are 6 fish and 2 caves. There are an equal number of fish in each cave.

How long does his concert last for?



- 6 An octopus has 8 legs.

How many legs do 2 octopuses have?



- 7 There are 14 oysters on the seabed.

Half of them start to open.

How many oysters start to open?



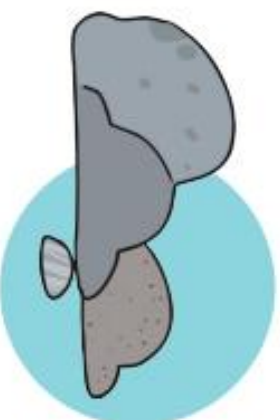
- 8 An equal number of starfish sleep on 5 rocks.

- 10 Sea snails like to rest on a rock in pairs. There are 12 rocks.

How many eggs does she lay altogether in one week?



- 11 Stan's band need to rehearse for 5 minutes every day.

In total, how many minutes do they rehearse for in a week?



- 12 Coral grows 2cm per year. Stan finds a piece that is 22cm tall.

How long has Stan's piece of coral been growing for?
