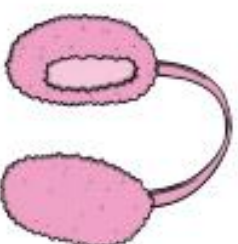

How many spiders came this year?

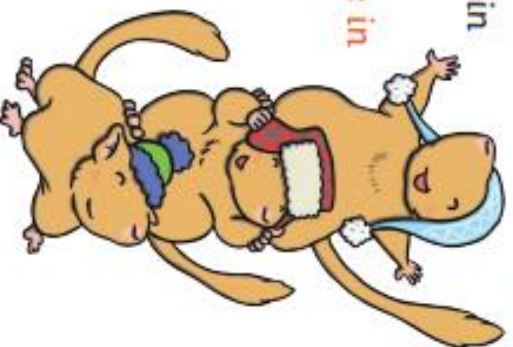
