## What Is Sports Day?

Sports day is a day when children take part in lots of different sporting activities at school.

Some schools have a whole day and some have a morning or afternoon of sports.

Sports Day is also sometimes known as Field Day or Athletics Day.



## When Is Sports Day?

Sports day is usually held outside, on the school field or playground, if the weather is fine.

Most schools in the UK hold their Sports Day in the summer term, during May, June or July.

Often, schools pick a date and also have a standby date, in case it rains on the first date.

## Who Comes to Watch?

Most schools invite parents, carers and other family members to come to watch and cheer. They are called 'spectators'.








