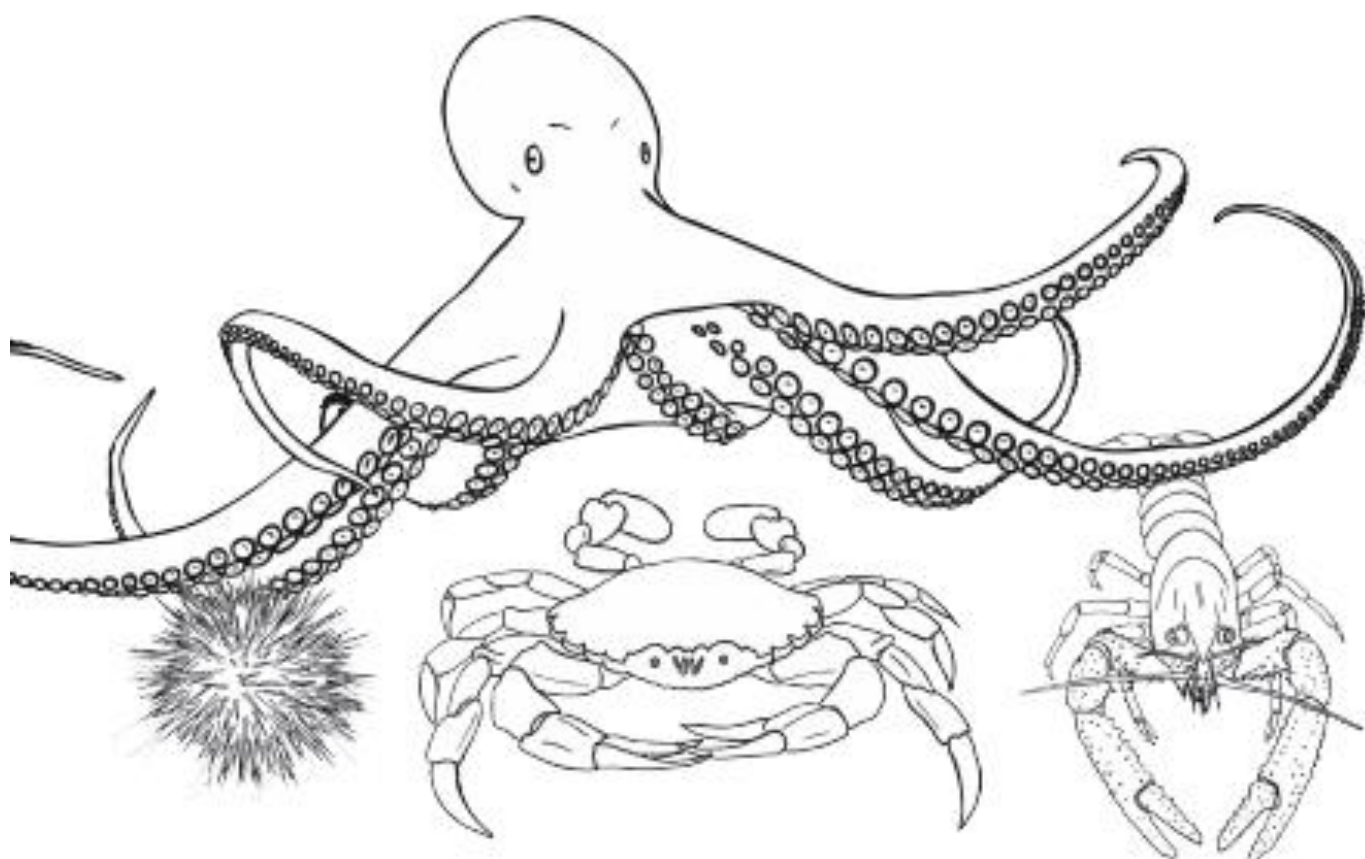
Crack the Codes under the Sea
