

Maths	Your challenge today is to complete some simple addition questions. I have attached a sheet with the addition sentences on and one with sea creatures. Cut around the sea creature picture cards, then stick them into the correct place on the addition sentence sheet to make the number sentences complete. Your child can now visually see the amounts of objects that have to be added together. Encourage your child to touch count each object until they are able to write the total into the empty box at the end of the number sentence. Ask your child to read out loud the number sentence in words. E.g. two starfish add 1 starfish makes three starfish	Your challenge today is to complete some simple addition questions. I have attached a sheet with the addition sentences on and one with sea creatures. Count each picture card to find out how many sea creatures there are, then write this amount into the empty boxes on the number sentence sheet. Your child might need some visual clues to help them add the numbers together. Encourage your child to touch count each object until they are able to write the total into the empty box at the end of the number sentence.
