You will receive class information to your email address from your child's new teacher over the holidays containing everything you need to know to come to school on the first day and ensure you have your new homework email address.

Up to 19th August we would be grateful if you could confirm positive PCR results for any pupil in our school by emailing admin@knypersley.staffs.sch.uk. This will enable us to support the Local Outbreak Team in identifying all close contacts and informing them to self-isolate.

It just leaves me to say THANK YOU AND WELL DONE to all of our children. They have been amazing this year, adapting to all the changes with a smile and determination to always try their best. Every member of staff has given their all to ensure they have kept the children and their colleagues safe and worked so hard to keep up with the curriculum and celebrate progress. Also to Mr Finch, who has looked after all of us, keeping us topped up with all the cleaning solutions needed during the day and everything running smoothly.
