All donations made on the day will then be made into hampers and raffled off during the nativity performances.





In order to be added to year group waitlists for one additional ticket please message via Arbor with your child's class teachers name at the start e.g. Mrs Minton: please can I request one more ticket for the Year 4 performance. We will work through the waitlist as best as possible assigning one ticket per applicant. If there are tickets remaining once we have allocated on the waitlist we will then message to re-open the waitlists for those who require more. Tickets will be assigned on a first come first served basis. We will only accept requests via Arbor to ensure messages are not missed. Ticket waitlists will open at 8am on Monday 2nd December, messages sent before this will not be accepted.

Faith in Focus Week

During our Faith in Focus week we have been exploring different religions in order to promote British Values. Our intent is to inform our children and to foster respect, tolerance, understanding and a wider sense of curiosity about other faiths and religions.

As part of our week, we have been to visit local churches, exploring world view where people have no specific faith. We are so proud of how the children have communicated their ideas and beliefs with the highest levels of respect. The classrooms have offered immersive experiences in order for children to gain a fuller understanding of the range of traditions and routines different religions have.

Our Year 2 and Year 4 children were fortunate enough to be visited by Mr Rashid who very kindly volunteered to share his knowledge around the Muslim faith. Mr Rashid shared many special items such as a prayer mat and also shared memories from Muslim Festivals he had taken part in. The information that Mr Rashid shared supported the children to then make comparisons to other religions/ Festivals that they explored over the week. We would like to say a huge thank you to Mr Rashid for his time, kindness and commitment to our children's learning.

All other classes had the opportunity throughout the week to visit our local churches, a huge thank you to St Johns Church and Life Stream Church who welcomed the children into their special place of worship. The children used the time within the Churches to explore key features and gain a full understanding of how Christians worship. All children took part over the week in a Faith Trail where they were able to incorporate map skills and outdoor learning alongside applying new knowledge around identification of key religious symbols/ items.

A huge thank you to Miss Massey who has worked hard behind the scenes to plan Faith in Focus week. We would also like to thank St John's Church and Life Stream Church for kindly opening their doors and being so very welcoming.
